

MEDICAL RETINA FELLOWSHIP

Narayana Nethralaya is one of the largest eye care providers in southern India. The hospital has been recognized by the DNB Board and the Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences for DNB ophthalmology and fellowship in the various subspecialties .

The Retina department has 8 full time consultants and 1 fellow. The department is a referral centre for managing simple and complex vitreo retinal diseases. State of art instruments like Constellation vitrectomy machine, pattern scan laser (PASCAL), Spectralis spectral domain OCT (ICG compatible), B scan help in providing a comprehensive and holistic care to the patients. The Dept performs approximately 200 fundus fl angiograms, 500 OCT, 300 lasers in a month. The hospital has an excellent support from the electro physiology Dept, which performs ERG, EOG and VEP in standardized conditions.

Diabetic retinopathy is a growing concern in the developing world including India. There is an acute shortage of trained personnel to tackle this problem. Narayana Nethralaya is glad to provide a 3 month fellowship in medical retina. The candidate shall learn to read and perform FFA, OCT, BSCAN. Adequate volumes will ensure the candidate is comfortable and confident in performing laser. Anti VEGF and steroids are increasingly being used to tackle complex vascular retinopathies, the fellow shall be given opportunity to administer them. The Retina department has the support of Uvea clinic and a very active ROP screening and treatment programme, the fellows will get the opportunity to perform LASER in ROP cases.
