COURSE OBJECTIVE

This course is meticulously crafted to provide ophthalmologists with immersive hands-on training in Small Incision Cataract Surgery (SICS) within the operation theatre. Additionally, participants will benefit from practical wet lab sessions conducted by experienced senior cataract surgeons, ensuring a comprehensive and skill-enhancing learning experience.

HIGHLIGHTS OF THE COURSE SCHEDULE

- Optimal wet lab facility for trainees.
 Virtual simulators for effective concept building and better hand eye co-ordination.
- ➤ The goal is to train ophthalmologists to become highly competent and meticulous trained surgeons in SICS.
- Surgeries are supervised by senior instructors until surgeon gains confidence to perform independent surgeries.
- Post-operative review of the cases done by senior consultants.
- Every training case is recorded and discussed at the end of the session for better recall and fine tuning of techniques.
- ➤ One on one discussions on topics like biometry, dealing with complicated cases, newer IOLs etc are conducted to help you plan your patient care.
